

**Разработка фрагмента урока для учащихся 5 класса с применением
английских диалогов-образцов**

5 и 6 уроки. Работа с диалогом из сказки «Jack and the beanstalk»



"Wake up, Jack. You must help me. There is nothing to eat for breakfast this morning. We can't buy any food because we haven't got any money".

"What shall we do, what shall we do?" said his mother.

"I'll go and get work somewhere," said Jack.

"You must sell Milky-white and with the money buy some bread, milk and honey on your way home.

"All right, mother," says Jack; "it's market-day today, and I'll soon sell Milky-white, and then we'll see what we can do."

"I see you haven't got Milky-white, so you've sold her. How much did you get for her?"

"You'll never guess, mother," says Jack, and adds "These beans are magical, we must plant them over-night and——"



He ran to the beanstalk and started to climb down, as quickly as he could.

"I must climb down quickly"

When Jack was almost in the garden he shouted to his mother: "the giant is coming!"

"I must chop down the beanstalk!"
The giant fell down.



When Jack climbed at the top of the beanstalk, he saw a big castle and ran to it. The giantess opened the door and said:

“You can’t come in here. The giant is coming home and he’ll eat you!”

The giantess ran into the kitchen and Jack followed her.

“You must hide!” My husband mustn’t see you! Quick! Get in the oven. You can hide behind the cake!”

Jack was very frightened. “Please, don’t let the giant eat me!”

Jack took the magic hen and the golden eggs and said: “Now I can go!”

**Make up the end of the dialogue.
Imagine what will happen when Jack
will plant those beans over-night?**

***“These beans are magical, plant them
over-night and——”***

Example:

-What will happen?

-I think there will be a magic tree!

-That’s amazing!

*-Yes, you’ll never guess what will be, when his
mother knew about it.*

Задания по сказке «Jack and the beanstalk» (5, 6 уроки):

Answer the questions with your partner using:

will/shall; won't (will never):

- 1) What shall Jack do?
- 2) When it's market day what will he do?
- 3) Will Jack's mother guess about the cost of their cow?



Jack helps his mother and he must sell their cow to buy some food for their breakfast.

And what about you?

Must you help your mother?

What must you do to help her with breakfast? (f. e. go to the shop/buy some food/cook some food/etc.)

What must you buy/cook for breakfast?

Answer the questions with your partner using:
must/mustn't:

- 1) Must Jack help his mother?
- 2) Jack and his mother don't have enough money. What must they do in such situation?
- 3) What must they do to the beans?
- 4) There is nothing to eat for breakfast this morning. What must Jack buy?
- 5) Where must Jack hide?
- 6) Why must he chop down the beanstalk?

For example:

- You must help me with breakfast, Kate! I am going to cook some porridge.*
- Of course, mum, what must I do?*
- You must buy some bread and milk.*
- OK. I must go to the shop and buy it then.*
- Oh, and you mustn't forget to buy some butter.*
- Yes, mum. I will do!*
- Thank you.*
